- 1) High School transcript.
- 2) Resume: One page only. Include activities community service, employment, honors/awards, leadership roles and career goals.
- 3) Two letters of recommendation commenting on your character and service to others.
- 4) One Statement: 100 words or less about your post-graduation plans. Include the name of the college you plan to attend and your intended major.
- 5) One Impact Essay: 500 words or less that includes a) how volunteerism at the Dublin Irish Festival has influenced you and b) how your volunteer service has made an impact on the Dublin Irish Festival.
